

## **TTW COACHING ACTIVITIES**

Table Tennis Wales are committed to ensure that everyone within the sport is clear about what is considered acceptable conduct in relation to the coaching activities of the sport.

The coaching activities procedures provide affiliated Clubs and Leagues, along with Regions and the National Governing Body, with reference points for managing activities and as such, assist in identifying unacceptable practice within the game. Breaches of what is considered acceptable conduct, can be dealt with at a local, regional or national level, as appropriate in each individual circumstance.

Table Tennis Wales had defined the following activities as central to its operation:

- Creating and maintaining a safe, welcoming and inclusive environment
- Supervising Children and Adults at Risk at table tennis sessions
- Managing Children and Adults at Risk away from the main training venue
- Organising junior age players in Competitions

The procedure for each activity is intended to provide staff and volunteers with the actions to be taking in relation to the specific situation, to ensure the potential risks for themselves and most importantly Children and Adults at Risk are kept to a minimum.
